2019 Year 9 Taranaki Diocesan School for Girls Scholarship Programme

The following Scholarships will be offered for 2019:

- Taranaki Dio Boarding Scholarship: \$2,000 per year for two years
- Taranaki Dio Academic Boarding Scholarship: \$2000 per year for two years
- Taranaki Dio Music Scholarship: \$1000 per year for two years, plus free tuition for singing or one musical instrument per year of scholarship. (With satisfactory performance this Music Scholarship can be extended.)

Please find attached the information package and application forms.

Applications for all Taranaki Dio Scholarships must be received on the prescribed application form by the Principal by 3 pm on Friday 2 November 2018.

Conditions of Scholarships:

1. Candidates will be judged on their merits and Taranaki Diocesan School for Girls reserves the right not to grant any scholarships if there are no candidates of sufficient merit.
2. Candidates may apply for one or more scholarship.
3. The value of the scholarship will be deducted from the recipients account in quarterly instalments during the year.
4. All scholarships will be reviewed annually.
5. Taranaki Diocesan School for Girls reserves the right to withdraw scholarships if, in the opinion of the Principal and after careful monitoring procedures, the student is performing significantly below expectations.

2018 Schedule for 2019 Taranaki Diocesan Scholarships

Applications for all Taranaki Dio Scholarships must be received on the prescribed application form by the Principal by 3pm on Friday 2 November 2018.

Short listed applicants will be invited to attend an interview with the Selection Panel on the afternoon of Thursday 15 November 2018 (prior to the 2019 New Girls Day on Friday 16 November).

All applicants will be contacted in writing and any scholarship offered must be accepted within a week of the offer being received.

Taranaki Diocesan School for Girls BOARDING 2019 Scholarship

For 2019 Taranaki Diocesan School for Girls will offer one Year 9 Boarding Scholarship to the candidate who shows evidence of need and who demonstrates the attributes that would support the special character of our boarding house. These include:

- A positive outlook
- Courtesy, kindness and respect
- An inclusive disposition
- High personal standards
- Demonstrated commitment to serving the needs of others

Students who have already enrolled and been accepted to Taranaki Diocesan School for Girls as day girls or boarders may apply. Any day girl or part boarder who is awarded the scholarship will be expected to become a weekly boarder for 2019 and 2020. Potential students into Taranaki Diocesan School for Girls who have not yet applied for enrolment may also apply for the Boarding Scholarship.

There are three components to the awarding of the Boarding Scholarship:

1. Application Form
2. Principal Endorsement from the student's current school Principal outlining the student's current contribution to serving others, her potential to become a positive role model in the boarding house setting, and that the family would benefit from financial assistance.
3. Short listed applicants will be invited to attend an interview with the Selection Panel on the afternoon of Thursday 15 November 2018 (prior to the 2019 New Girls Day on Friday 16 November)

Taranaki Diocesan School for Girls ACADEMIC BOARDING 2019 Scholarship

For 2019 Taranaki Diocesan School for Girls will offer one Year 9 Academic Boarding Scholarship to a candidate who shows evidence of need and has achieved all round excellence in academic performance. Students who have already enrolled and been accepted to Taranaki Diocesan School for Girls as day girls or boarders may apply. Any day girl or part boarder who is awarded the scholarship will be expected to become a weekly boarder for 2019 and 2020. Potential students into Taranaki Diocesan School for Girls who have not yet applied for enrolment may also apply for the Academic Boarding Scholarship.

There are four components to the awarding of the Academic Boarding Scholarship:

1. Application Form
2. Principal's Endorsement from the student's current school Principal outlining the student's academic profile, her potential to become a positive role model in the boarding house setting, and that the family would benefit from financial assistance
3. By highest mark achieved in an examination in open competition held on the New Girls Day on Friday 16 November 2018. The examination will cover general knowledge, and academic subjects, in particular English, Social Studies, Mathematics and Science.
4. Short listed applicants will be invited to attend an interview with the Selection Panel on the afternoon of Thursday 15 November 2018 (prior to the 2019 New Girls Day on Friday 16 November)

Taranaki Diocesan School for Girls 2019 MUSIC Scholarship

Taranaki Diocesan School for Girls will offer one Year 9 Music Scholarship in 2019 if a candidate of sufficient merit presents themselves. The recipient of the Music Scholarship is expected to take full part in the musical life of the school which could include participating in the choir and/or ensemble.

The Taranaki Dio Music Scholarship is reviewed annually in conjunction with the music teacher. The Junior Music Scholar may be awarded a Senior Music Scholarship after the initial two years, subject to satisfactory performance and a continued participation in the musical life of Taranaki Diocesan.

We will contact applicants in advance if an audition is necessary.
